



World Barre Summit COVID-19 Policy Effective 09/14/2021

We are excited to see everyone for the 4th annual World Barre Summit, October 14-17, 2021. Whether you are attending in person or virtually, we are going to reconnect and continue to grow the Barre fitness community together.

For those traveling to the in-person event at the Westin Beach Resort, in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, we are providing this updated policy for everyone coming to the event, including presenters, vendors, attendees, and Barre Summit staff.

Vaccination/Testing Policy

To ensure that we have a safe event for everyone, we will be requiring one of these two options to attend the World Barre Summit:

1. Negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of October 15, 2021.
 - Physical paper, e-mail, or text message showing negative COVID-19 test results are acceptable forms of proof.
2. At least one COVID-19 vaccination taken prior to October 1, 2021.
 - Physical vaccination card or picture of vaccination card are acceptable forms of proof.

Mask Policy

The Westin Beach Resort requires its hotel associates to always wear face masks; however, the hotel does not require guests to wear them. The Barre Summit team will be wearing masks in our event space.

Arriving to the Event

All participants will come to the Barre Summit registration desk (not the hotel front desk) upon arrival to the event to show proof of one of the two requirements above and sign our COVID-19 liability waiver. After those steps are complete, we will provide you with your name badge to enter sessions at the event. As a reminder, this process needs to be followed by all participants, including presenters, vendors, attendees, and our staff.

Session Safety

While the hotel does not require masks to be worn, to ensure a safe environment in our session rooms, we will be providing ample space between the portable barres used in sessions as well as sitting chairs used for lectures. Please make sure you are six feet apart from others while taking sessions. We have kept our class maxes lower to ensure that session rooms will not have too many people in them at once.

We understand that these policies can sometimes create division amongst us, but as professionals and leaders in the industry, let us set a positive example for the community by working together to provide a safe and welcoming environment for everyone at the event.
